

Vocabulary

Flag Terms

- Staff (or flagpole) The pole that the flag is raised on.
- Staff Ornament (or Finial) A decorative piece that may be on top of the staff.
- Halyard A rope used to raise and lower a flag.
- Canton Any quarter of a flag, but often the upper hoist (left) quarter.
- Hoist End The half or edge of a flag closest to the flagpole.
- Charge A figure or symbol appearing in the field of a flag.
- **Fly End** The half or edge of a flag farthest from the flagpole. This is the end that flaps in the wind.
- Field The background of a flag.






Layers of the Earth

- **Inner Core** A solid mass, thought to be made of nickel and iron, and believed to be the same temperature as the sun.
- Outer Core A very hot liquid made of nickel and iron.
- Mantle A large, rocky shell between the core and the crust.
- **Crust** Thin layer on top of the mantle. This layer is the one we live on.
