Extension Activities

Each month we provide curriculum, instruction, and materials for many activities. We also provide a list of “Extension Activities.” These activities are not covered in our video training and may require additional items from home.

Visit a Cave

Plan a visit to a cave or cavern to explore with your child. They will love looking at all the cave formations and will better understand the concepts presented in the Toolbox.

Cave Scenes

Using the pastels, or other drawing materials from your home, draw pictures of the different cave scenes. You can draw caves that have animals living in them, caves with formations, and different types of caves (lava tunnels, sea caves, etc.).

Pastels

Use the pastels with other types of paper (construction, copy, cardboard, etc.) to create different kinds of art.

Bear Counting Extensions

- Use the cards numbered 0-9 to collect objects from around the house. Have the child bring the items to a designated work space, like a table or rug and place them under the correct card.
- Place the cards numbered 0-9 face down in random order in a pile. As your child flips over each card, have them count out the correct number of bears that are on the card. This allows you to be sure your child correctly associates the quantity with the numeral. For children who have not yet grasped the concept of zero, you can leave that card out.
