

Land Formation Card Instructions

- 1. Watch Video 1 for Land, Water, Air Toolbox in the Resources section
 - a. Video marker 2:44 begins the discussion about creating the land formation cards.
- 2. After cutting the sandpaper into the four pieces use the templates below to trace the land formation onto the back for the sandpaper
- 3. Cut out the formation shape
 - a. e.g. Island: trace around the island template on the back of one of the sandpaper pieces.
- 4. Use an x-acto knife (or similar) to cut out the traced shape on the sandpaper.
 - a. This creates the pieces needed for two separate formation cards
 - i. e.g. Island tracing will provide the pieces for Island and Lake cards
- 5. Find the corresponding land formation cards (the front is solid blue and the back has the formation name)
- 6. Remove the adhesive from the back of the sandpaper pieces that you cut.
- 7. Adhere the corresponding shape to the appropriate land formation card.


Strait / Isthmus
